## Rules & Regulations:

1. **All Exhibitors must show in Showmanship or they will not be eligible to show in other classes. Showmanship class must be entered on entry form.**
2. **All animals will be shown in ONLY one individual class.**
3. If exhibitors need help in group classes, helpers must be youth. See superintendent if this is a problem.
4. Dress code is western attire. **No farm names should be on show attire.**
5. Showmanship classes will be judged first.
6. Only one exhibitor/person is allowed in the ring with an animal, with the exception of group classes.
7. Cattle Exhibitor Handbook Available.
8. Be sure to include exhibitor's birth date on entry form.
9. **Exhibitor harnesses must be used.**
10. **Exhibitors must use Cattle Trails when moving animals.**
11. Youth Beef exhibitors are limited to **10 animals.**

## SECTION 7 – COMMERCIAL/CROSSBRED BEEF CATTLE

### Class No.

1. **Junior Bull Calf**, born after January 1, 2011 (at least 3 months old on day of show)
- **All Breed Bull Calf Champion & Reserve All Breed Bull Calf Champion**
2. **Junior Heifer Calf**, born after March 1, 2011 (at least 3 months old on day of show)
3. **Intermediate Heifer Calf**, Born January 1<sup>st</sup> – February 28, 2011
4. **Senior Heifer Calf**, born September 1, 2010 – December 31, 2010
5. **Summer Yearling Heifer**, born May 1, 2010 – August 31, 2010
6. **Junior Yearling Heifer**, born January 1, 2010 – April 31, 2010
7. **Senior Yearling Heifer**, born Sept. 1, 2009 – December 31, 2009
- **Junior Champion & Reserve Junior Champion**
8. **Cow Without A Nursing Calf**  
**NOTE:** Calves shown in Cow/Calf classes must have been shown in their individual classes and be a Jr. Bull, Jr. or Intermediate Heifer or Feeder Class 1. If a registered cow has a crossbred calf, enter both in Section 7.
9. **Cow/Calf, Cows 2-3 Yrs.** (Calf at least 3 months old on day of show)
10. **Cow/Calf, Cows 4-6 Yrs.** (Calf at least 3 months old on day of show)
11. **Cow/Calf, Cows 7 & Older** (Calf at least 3 months old on day of show)
- **Senior Champion & Reserve Senior Champion**
- **Breed Grand Champion & Reserve Grand Champion**
- **All Breed Grand Champion & All Breed Reserve Champion**  
**NOTE:** Grand Champion & Reserve Grand Champion of each breed will compete for All-Breed Champion & Reserve All Breed Champion
12. **Best Pair of Females**, bred & owned by exhibitor
13. **Pair of Yearlings**, can be from same family farm but owned by different family members. Animals must have been shown in Classes 5 – 7.
14. **Pair of Calves**, can be from same family farm but owned by different family members. Animals must have been shown in Classes 1 - 4.

## **SECTION 8 – MEAT ANIMALS**

### **Class No.**

1. **Feeder**, born January 1, 2011 – May 15, 2011 (meat animal, female, or castrated male, need not be purebred) If the feeder is a female, may not enter animal in purebred or commercial calf classes.
2. **Feeder**, born Sept. 1, 2010 – Dec. 1, 2010 (meat animal, female, or castrated male, need not be purebred) If the feeder is a female, may not enter animal in purebred or commercial calf classes.
- **Grand Champion Feeder & Reserve Grand Champion Feeder**, Ribbon only
3. **Pair of Feeders**, from Classes 1 & 2 above- can be from same family/farm but owned by different family members)
4. **Meat Animal**, over 1 year & under 2-weight classes to be set at fair. Must be ready for market.
- **Champion & Reserve in Lightweight, Middleweight, & Heavyweight Animals, Grand Champion Animal, Reserve Grand Champion Animal**, Ribbon only
5. **Pair of Meat Animals – must have shown in Class 4** (can be from same family/farm but owned by different family members)

**NOTE:** Exhibitors are encouraged to weigh the animals in Class 4 prior to the fair and have weight papers available. Animals will be divided into 3 weight groups.

## **SECTION 9 – SPECIAL EVENTS**

**Beef Showmanship emphasis on showing and control of animal. Be sure to enter showmanship class on entry form.**

The judge will make awards considering the following points:

- a) *Control of Animal:*
  1. Control of animal by exhibitor.
  2. Poise and coolness of exhibitor.
  3. Skill in showing animal to best advantage.
- b) *Preparation of Animal for showing:*
  1. Condition of feet and trimming of feet.
  2. Cleanliness and condition of hide and hair.
  3. Personal appearance including neatness and cleanliness of clothing of the exhibitor.

### **Class No.**

1. **Novice Showmanship**, never shown a beef animal before
2. **Beef Showmanship**, Contest will be divided into age classes at the fair.
- **Master & Reserve Showmanship**, Ribbon only (1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> place individual in each age group to compete)
3. **Herdsmanship Beef** (Exhibitors in Youth Barn are expected to enter Herdsmanship contest, and are eligible for Youth Division only.) For outstanding Creative or Educational Displays – Special Ribbon given.
4. **Best Dressed Animal**, Friday @ 7:00 pm (see Dept. 101 for information) Write class on entry form- post-entries will be allowed.
