## Rules & Regulations:

1. **All youth exhibitors must show in Showmanship to be eligible to show in other classes.**
2. Exhibitors may show **only one animal** per class.
3. Neatness and appearance of show person will be considered. **Long white pants & white sleeved shirt must be worn and tucked in.** Farm names & letters are not permitted on the show attire. No hats allowed. Youth goat club shirts may be worn.
4. All milking goats will be shown with no more than 18 hours of milk.
5. The fair will provide some pens.
6. Goat exhibitors are encouraged to decorate their exhibit in an appropriate manner.
7. Fiber or meat goats may have horns but must have protection-contact Open or Youth Superintendents prior to bringing animals.
8. ADGA Rules will apply unless otherwise stated.
9. Animals should be clipped prior to arrival at the Fair, ideally 1 – 2 weeks before.
10. Goats should be washed at wash stations only.
11. Goats are to remain in pens or in areas designated by Superintendents.
12. Barn meeting on Monday @ 6:00 pm.
13. Check barn for times when health and registration papers will be checked and vet check.

**SECTION 11 – GOAT SHOWMANSHIP**

**Class No.**

- 1. **Novice**, *first time exhibitor (any age)*
- 2. **Showmanship**- classes will be divided by Superintendent and posted
- **Master Showman**

All exhibitors must enter. Ribbons will be awarded on the Danish System. The judges will consider the following:

Appearance of Animal .....	40 points
Appearance of Exhibitor .....	10 points
Presenting Animal in Ring.....	<u>50 points</u>
Total	100 points

**SECTION 12 – SPECIAL EVENTS**

**Class No.**

- 1. **Best Dressed Goat**, To be held in Sheep/Goat Ring, Friday @ 6 pm, *see Best Dressed Calf rules, Dept. 101*  
*Write on entry blank- post-entries will be allowed.*
- 2. **Milking Goat Demonstrations**, *sign up with superintendent on Monday of Fair – no award*
- 3. **Goat Games**, *Ribbon only, Sunday afternoon, Enter at event.*

**Barn Herdsmanship/Shepherds**, *Prizes to be awarded based on points received in daily inspections of displays in the barn and the display designs: attractiveness and educational components. All sheep and goat exhibits will be entered in competition. Additional information will be available from superintendents.*
