**NOTICE: All poultry except waterfowl and pigeons shown at State or County Fairs shall have originated from US Pullorum clean flocks or have negative Pullorum-Typhoid test within 90 days of fair.**

## Rules & Regulations:

1. A limit of 2 entries in any one class may be made by one exhibitor, unless otherwise stated.
2. Birds must be of acceptable age and condition or the superintendent will reject the entry.
3. Exhibitors should be present for the judging of this department.
4. Every exhibit should be labeled accordingly to Breed & Variety.
5. Coops will be furnished for all birds.
6. It is recommended that no birds be shown from commercial flocks.
7. Birds must have been owned by the exhibitor for at least 30 days prior to the exhibition date.
8. Exhibited birds should not be returned to the home premises or any other premises where birds are harbored.
9. All birds should be moved to and from the fair in clean disinfected crates & trunks.
10. All possible precaution should be used to prevent tracking disease agents from the exhibition to other premises.
11. All birds will be fed & cared for without charge. NOTE: It seems best that all watering & feeding of birds be left to the superintendent & assistants unless permission is granted.
