SECTION 1 - TEXTILE & NEEDLE ARTS

More than 1 entry can be made in any class, as long as different skills are used.

Class No.

1. **Hand Sewn Articles**, *for example, sewing box accessories.*
2. **Machine Sewn Articles**, *can be clothing or an accessory. (Some hand sewing is acceptable.) Be prepared to share verbally years of experience in sewing and skills gained.*
3. **Modeling of Garment Entry**, *time will be scheduled with the superintendent on **Saturday, August 22nd**.*
4. **Needle Arts** - *examples include needlepoint, counted cross stitch, embroidery, knitting, crocheting, latch hooking, rug hooking, tatting or felting. (Limit of 1 entry per technique)*
5. **Major Items of Fabric Furnishing**, *such as a bedspread, coverlet, quilt, dust ruffle, curtains, draperies, 2 pillow cases, rug etc. Must be accompanied by a statement stating: (a) fabric content; (b) color scheme of room Example: major areas of light buff, secondary areas of medium brown with orange accents; (c) if heritage item, historical background connected with it.*
