All cattle must be on Fairgrounds by **5 pm Monday, August 22**. **NO EXHIBITS REMOVED UNTIL 6:00 am Monday, August 29**. **ALL EXHIBITS MUST BE REMOVED BY 6 p.m.**

Rules & Regulations:

- All cattle exhibitors wishing to remove a part of their exhibit** in order to show at the N.Y.S. Fair must notify the cattle superintendents on or before **5:00 p.m. Monday, August 22**.
- Exhibitors of herds or a representative in charge, must be in attendance at all times.
- All animals in the Cattle Department must be registered, and papers will be checked. All papers will remain with the animal during fair week.
- Registration papers are final proof of ownership of all livestock exhibited at Fair. **NO PAPERS PENDING.**
- REGISTRATION and CHECK-IN PROCESS:**
 - Schedule for barns will be posted in Entry Office, Ag Center, Judging Arena and Youth Barn.*
 - Exhibitors will bring registration papers & entry print-outs to Judging Arena at assigned time.*
 - Papers will be checked for dates, entry issues, ownership & to verify that correct animals are entered.*
 - Scratches will be taken at this time; these will not appear in Judge's Books nor can the animal be shown.*
 - When process is completed, exhibitor will sign office copy of entry report; show numbers will then be issued.*
 - Youth exhibitors will confirm their age/date of birth.*
- GENETIC RECOVERY ANIMALS — Any third generation animal of any breed that is in a Genetic Recovery Program with registration papers showing a GR prefix may be shown in competition. OA or PR animals are ineligible to be shown. (87.5%)**
- All animals must have been owned by all listed owners by June 15th of current year. **If the primary farm is located & operated in Washington County but the owner is a non-resident, they will be allowed to exhibit their animals at the fair.**
- Exhibitors are responsible for keeping their animals under control, regardless of who handles them.**
- All animals must be entered and shown in single classes to compete in group classes.
- Only one showman/person will be allowed in the ring with an animal with the exception of group classes.*
- Superintendents will try to honor stall requests in placing animals, however, due to space limitations exhibitors may not get the spot requested.**
- On **Saturday, Sunday & Monday**, prior to the opening of the fair, exhibitors are to follow one-way traffic pattern shown on map.
- Cattle Handbook available. One (1) book per family / farm.
- It is required that exhibitor's harnesses be used for the show.
- Exhibitors are required to use Cattle trails when moving animals on grounds.
- If you want your own water tank, you must provide your own.** WC Fair tanks are for general use.

1. **Spring Heifer Calf**, born on or after March 1, 2011 and at least 3 months old at show
2. **Winter Heifer Calf**, born after Nov. 30, 2010 and before March 1, 2011
3. **Fall Heifer Calf**, born after Aug. 31, 2010 and before Dec. 1, 2010
4. **Summer Yearling Heifer**, born after May 31, 2010 and before Sept. 1, 2010
5. **Spring Yearling Heifer**, born after Feb. 28, 2010 and before June 1, 2010
6. **Winter Yearling Heifer**, born after Nov. 30, 2009 and before March 1, 2010
7. **Fall Yearling Heifer**, (not in milk) born after Aug. 31, 2009 and before Dec. 1, 2009
- **Junior Champion & Reserve Junior Champion**, Ribbon only
8. **Junior Best 3 Females** (Must be bred by exhibitor but not necessarily owned by exhibitor)
9. **Junior 2 yr. Old Cow**, born after March 1, 2009 and before Aug. 31, 2009
10. **Senior 2 yr. Old Cow**, born after Sept. 1, 2008 and before Feb. 28, 2009
11. **Junior 3 Year Old Cow**, born after March 1, 2008 and before Aug. 31, 2008
12. **Senior 3 Year Old Cow**, born after Sept. 1, 2007 and before Feb. 28, 2008
- **Intermediate Champion & Reserve Intermediate Champion**, Ribbon only
13. **4 Year Old Cow**, born after Aug. 31, 2006 and before Sept. 1, 2007
14. **5 Year Old Cow**, born after Aug. 31, 2005 and before Sept. 1, 2006
15. **6 - 10 Year Old Cow**, born after Aug. 31, 2001 and before Sept. 1, 2005
16. **Dry Cow - 5 Years and Under**, must have calved at least once but is not presently milking. Dry cows cannot be shown in any other individual class, but can be shown in groups.
17. **Dry Cow - 6 Years and Over**
- **Senior Champion Cow & Reserve Senior Champion**, Ribbon only
- **Grand Champion Cow & Reserve Grand Champion**, Ribbon only
- **Best Udder**, that has calved at least once & now in milk. Ribbon & \$32.00 awarded to winner.
(Animals designated by judge.)

Class No.

18. **Dairy Herd**, 3 cows, two years old or over that have all calved at least once & are owned by exhibitor.
19. **Senior Best 3 Females**, 2 yrs. & older, bred by exhibitor but not necessarily owned by exhibitor
20. **Produce of Cow**, two females, not necessarily owned by exhibitor.
21. **Daughter-Dam**, a daughter-dam combination of any age, not necessarily owned by exhibitor.
- **All Breed Champion and Reserve Champion**, Ribbon only

Premier Breeder and Premier Exhibitor Banners will be awarded in each breed.

The following point system will be used. Top 6 head will be counted.
