Rules and Regulations:

1. Rules for Dairy Cattle (Department. 2) will apply.
2. All Beef Cattle must be halter broken.
3. All Animals being shown in Sections 1-6 will be purebred and accompanied by registration papers. **Date for ownership and transfers is June 15th.** This includes calf classes.
4. Exhibitors showing animals in Section 7-Commercial/Crossbred need a statement stating the breeding and age of the animals. All of the above mentioned papers will be checked by the Superintendent.
5. **All animals must be shown in individual classes in order to show them in group classes.**
6. Only one showman/person will be allowed in the ring with an animal with the exception of group classes.
7. **NO PAPERS PENDING.**
8. **Superintendents will try to honor stall requests in placing animals, however, due to space limitations exhibitors may not get the spot requested.**
9. Cattle Exhibitors Handbook available.
10. It is required that exhibitor's harnesses be used for the show.

Class No.

1. Junior Bull Calf, born after January 1, 2010 and must be 3 months old at show.
- All Breed Champion Bull Calf & All Breed Reserve Champion Bull Calf-Ribbon only
2. Junior Heifer Calf, born after March 1, 2010 and must be 3 months old at show.
3. Intermediate Heifer Calf, born January 1, 2010 - February 28, 2010
4. Senior Heifer Calf, born September 1, 2009 - December 31, 2009
5. Summer Yearling Heifer, born May 1, 2009- August 31, 2009
6. Junior Yearling Heifer, born January 1, 2009 - April 30, 2009
7. Senior Yearling Heifer, born September 1, 2008- December 31, 2008
- Junior Breed Champion & Reserve Junior Breed Champion-Ribbon only

NOTE: Calves shown in cow/calf classes must have been shown in their individual classes and be a Jr. Bull, Jr. Heifer, Intermediate Heifer, or Feeder Class 1. If a registered cow has a crossbred calf, enter both in section 7.

8. Cow/Calf - Cows 2-3 Years Old
9. Cow/Calf - Cows 4-6 Years Old
10. Cow/Calf - Cows 7 Years Old & Over
- Senior Breed Champion & Reserve Senior Breed Champion, Ribbon only
- Breed Grand Champion & Reserve Breed Grand Champion, Ribbon only
- All Breed Grand Champion & Reserve All Breed Grand Champion, Ribbon only

NOTE: Breed & Reserve Breed Grand Champions from each breed will compete for All Breed Grand Champion

11. Get of Sire, 3 animals sired by the same bull and owned by exhibitor, may include bull calves.
12. Best 2 Females, bred & owned by exhibitor
13. Pair of Yearlings, females owned by exhibitor
14. Pair of Calves, from classes 1, 2, 3, or 4 & owned by exhibitor

NOTE: Premier Breeder & Premier Exhibitor banners will be awarded in Sections 1-6. See Dept. 2 Dairy for point system. Premier Exhibitor only will be awarded in Section 7.

SECTION 8 - MEAT ANIMALS

Animals in Class 4 will be divided into 3 weight groups (at the fair) and awards paid in each. Exhibitors are encouraged to weigh the animals prior to fair and have the weight paper available.

A female or castrated male; need not be purebred. If the feeder is a female, may not enter animal in purebred or commercial calf classes.

1. **Feeder**, *born 1/01/10 - 5/15/10*
2. **Feeder**, *born 9/01/09 - 12/31/09*
-- **Grand Champion Feeder & Reserve Grand Champion Feeder**, *Ribbon only*
3. **Pair of Feeders**, *must have been shown in Class 1 or 2, can be from same family/farm but owned by different family members*
4. **Meat Animal**, *over 1 year and under 2 years old*
-- **Champion & Reserve Champion Lightweight, Middleweight, & Heavy Steers**
-- **Grand Champion Meat Animal & Reserve Grand Champion Meat Animal**, *Ribbon only*
5. **Pair of Meat Animals from Class 4**, *Can be from same family/farm but owned by different family members*

BEEF HERDSMANSHIP, Refer to Department 2- Dairy for information. Junior exhibitors housed in open barns will be included in their farms' Herdsmanship- do not enter in youth.
