**Section 1 - Entry fee is \$2.00 per class      Section 2- No entry fee.**

## Rules & Regulations:

1. All entries must be in place by **9:45 a.m.** on Monday.
2. Each exhibitor may enter only once in each class.
3. All entries must be by one individual (exception: group class farm scene).
4. Fair will provide shelving w/protective covering. Shelves are 12" deep x 12" high. Max length of entry is 8'.
5. Classes to be judged for authenticity, quality, theme, originality, and condition. Toys only to be judged. Literature and other non-toy pieces will not be judged as a part of the display but are encouraged to enhance the displays for the fair patrons.
6. *Customized - Definition:* mass produced toys altered/modified/changed to be different from stock product.
7. *Definition of Stock:* mass produced toys unaltered from original production.
8. For security reasons it would be appreciated if each adult exhibitor would volunteer to man the Toy Building for at least 1 shift during fair. Time may be scheduled prior to the fair by contacting the show superintendent. A scheduling sheet will be available during fair week. A day pass will be issued to each person who volunteers to man the Toy Building for each day they are scheduled. **PLEASE HELP!**

## **SECTION 1 - OPEN**

**Awards for Classes 1-16:    First \$20.00;    Second \$15.00;    Third \$10.00;    Fourth \$5.00**

### **Class No.**

1. **1/64 stock**, 30 pieces max.
2. **1/64 customized**, purchased, 15 pieces max.
3. **1/64 customized by exhibitor**, 15 pieces max.
4. **1/32 stock**, 10 pieces max.
5. **1/16 stock**, 10 pieces max.
6. **1/16 customized**, 10 pieces max.
7. **1/16 custom**, modified or scratch built by owner, 5 pieces max.
8. **1/16 Best Display of 1 Brand**, 10 pieces max. (May be stock, custom or both.)

## **SPECIALTY CLASSES**

9. **Agriculture Related Antique-** items need to be a minimum of 25 years old- 4 foot shelf
10. **Other, AG RELATED small display 4'** (examples: related memorabilia, construction toys, trucks, etc.)
11. **Other, AG RELATED large display 8'** (examples: related memorabilia, construction toys, trucks, etc.)
12. **Stock Pedal Tractor**, un-restored — original condition — limit 1.
13. **Pedal Tractor**, restored
14. **Display of NASCAR Die cast or Memorabilia (max 8')**
15. **Agricultural related diorama**, miniature display, maximum 2' x 4'. 10 piece maximum, no height restrictions. .  
*Must be mounted on a firm base. Exhibitor does not need to be present for judging.*
16. **Agricultural Toys**, All sizes, all brands, 8' shelf, 10 pieces maximum, no height restrictions
17. **Other-** not limited to Agricultural related items: can include collectables, memorabilia (hats, pins, sports, Hess trucks, firetrucks, etc.) 2' shelf space, no limits on number of pieces  
--- **Best of Show Trophy**, will be awarded as judge's choice, awarded from first place winners from Classes 1-17

## **SECTION 2 – YOUTH - Youth Only – Ribbons only awarded.**

### **Class No.**

1. **1/64 stock** (exhibitors 5 and under), 15 pieces max.
2. **1/64 stock** (exhibitors 6-10 years), 15 pieces max.
3. **1/64 stock** (exhibitors 11-16 years), 15 pieces max.
4. **1/16 stock** (exhibitors 5 and under), 5 pieces max.
5. **1/16 stock** (exhibitors 6-10 years), 5 pieces max.
6. **1/16 stock** (exhibitors 11-16 years), 5 pieces max.
7. **1/32 stock** (exhibitors 10 and under), 10 pieces, max.
8. **1/32 stock** (exhibitors 11-16 years), 10 pieces max.
9. **Display of NASCAR Die cast or Memorabilia (max. 4')**
10. **Other**, not limited to Agricultural related items: can include collectables, memorabilia (hats, pins, sports, Hess Trucks, firetrucks, etc.) Two foot shelf space; no limit on number of pieces  
- **Best of Show**, Ribbon only, each age group
