Poultry (with the exception of doves, pigeons & waterfowl) must be accompanied by: **1)** results of a negative Pullorum-typhoid test conducted within 90 days prior to exhibition **OR 2)** proof that the birds originate directly from a US Pullorum-typhoid clean flock or equivalent flock. U.S. Pullorum-typhoid clean or equivalent testing must be within 2 yrs. of exhibition.

Rules & Regulations:

1. Birds must have been owned by the exhibitor for at least 30 days prior to the exhibition date.
2. Exhibited birds should not be returned to home premises or any other premises where birds are harbored.
3. All birds should be moved to and from the fair in clean, disinfected crates and trunks.
4. All possible precaution should be used to prevent tracking disease agents from exhibit to other premises.
5. Entry process is on page 3.
6. All entries will be entered by breed and variety.
7. A limit of two (2) entries in any one class may be made by one exhibitor.
8. All exhibits must be on the grounds by **4 p.m. Monday, August 24, 2009.**
9. A trio shall consist of 1 male & 2 females and may not be entered as single entries in this department.
10. Only chickens can exhibit as trios.
11. Birds must be of acceptable age and condition or the superintendent will reject the entry.
12. All birds will be fed and cared for without charge. Coops will be furnished as far as possible.
13. Exhibitors should be present for the judging in this department.
14. No exhibits may be removed before **7am** and must be removed by **6 pm, Monday, Aug. 31st.**
15. Single exhibitors in a class shall receive second award unless the Judge deems the exhibit outstanding.
16. All chickens, ducks, turkeys, and geese will be judged according to Standards of Perfection.

SECTION 20 – WASH. CO. ROOSTER CROWING CHAMPIONSHIP CONTEST

Class No.

1. **Crowing Contest**, no entry fee (Wednesday through Friday 6:30 p.m.)

- **Special Award** A ribbon to the champion bird.
- **Laryngitis Award:** A ribbon to each exhibitor in the contest whose bird did not crow during any part of the competition.

The crowing contest will be presented each evening at 6:30 p.m. The contests will be based solely on the number of “crows” during a specific 15-minute period. The volume, tone, musical quality and other features of a rooster’s crow will not count. The rooster having the most crows recorded to his credit at the end of the week (after Friday’s contest) will be deemed THE CHAMPION! All breeds and varieties of poultry entered in the regular classes are eligible. However, you must enter this on the entry form. Exhibitors or their representatives are to be present each night and are responsible for seeing their birds(s) are placed in competition and returned to their own coops.

Exhibitors may enter a total of 2 roosters.
