Health and Safety

The Washington County Fair asks visitors to follow posted signs and practice safe hygiene when visiting our Fairgrounds. Interacting with animals is an important part of the fair experience. Despite the many benefits of interacting with animals, people should be aware that animals can carry germs that make people sick.

Animal-borne disease can cause a variety of illnesses, from minor skin rashes to serious infections. Diseases that pass from animals to humans are called zoonotic diseases and can include E. coli, Salmonella and Campylobacter. Older adults, pregnant women, young children and people with weakened immune systems may be especially vulnerable. By following some simple health tips, you and your family are less likely to get sick from touching or being around animals at the Fair.

Fair visitors should wash their hands with soap and water before and after touching any animal and never eat, drink or put anything in your mouth while in an animal exhibit or contact area. We also encourage parents and caregivers to consider leaving strollers outside and carry small children when visiting in these areas.

Adults should supervise hand washing for young children making sure children wash hands properly with soap and water after interaction with animals. Use hand sanitizer if soap and water are not readily available. The Washington County Fair has Hand Sanitizer Stations located in primary areas on the Fairgrounds to supplement our rest room sinks. These stations are available in food areas as well as in animal contact areas.

Career and Technical Education Day

Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs provide students who are hands-on learners an opportunity to master academic and technical skills within subject areas that interest them.

The Washington-Saratoga-Warren-Hamilton-Essex BOCES has sponsored Friday's events for this year's fair and will offer a full day of events featuring students demonstrating some of WSWHE BOCES CTE programs.

Maribeth Macica, the organization's senior public information specialist, said CTE programs are for students entering 11th and 12th grades from the 31 school districts within their five-county region. The students attend one of two technical education centers located in Saratoga Springs and Hudson Falls.

"They graduate with industry credentials that they can use to go on to college, a technical school or go straight into the workforce," Macica said.

The purpose of the CTE demonstrations is to spread the word about the 24 programs available through the WSWHE BOCES CTE program and to answer questions about what is available.

"We feel it is important to introduce parents to what their children can do in the coming years," Macica said. "Students will demonstrate the skills they have acquired at CTE to show the public what these programs are really all about and to give kids and their parents a preview of what they can do if they choose CTE."

So much attention has been given to the skills gap in the United States. The WSWHE BOCES CTE program is pleased to be doing its part in closing that gap by preparing the next generation of skilled workers and industry innovators. CTE allows students who know what they want to pursue to get a head start on their career field and allows those who haven't yet decided what their future holds to explore a variety of options.

"It's hands-on and exposes the students to these opportunities early," Macica said.

Students and instructors from the Washington-Saratoga-Warren-Hamilton-Essex (WSWHE) BOCES Career and Technical Education programs will host live, hands-on demonstrations throughout fair week. Visitors can explore skills in



culinary arts, public service, trades and more, guided by the students themselves.

On Monday, Culinary Arts and Hospitality students will invite visitors to decorate cupcakes, offering a fun and creative start to the week. On Tuesday, Health Occupations students will guide participants in making slime models while teaching about blood. Animal Science students will share grooming and CPR techniques. Early Childhood Education students will lead crafts for young children, and Technology and Trades students will demonstrate automotive wiring using a circuit trainer.

On Wednesday, Culinary students will serve fresh salsa and watermelon

fresca. HVAC students will showcase piping practices, while **Automotive** Technology students demonstrate diagnostic tools. Visitors can also try operating a mini excavator with quidance from Heavy Equipment students. On Thursday, Early Childhood Education returns with bubble play and wand-making. **Health Occupations** will repeat the blood activity. **Construction Trades** students will help build small projects, Cosmetology will offer hair wraps, and Welding students will demonstrate torchcutting and share program info.

Friday is the big CTE Day at the fair. Demonstrations are held throughout the day in twohour blocks. Auto Body students will demonstrate paintless dent repair. The excavator returns with the Heavy Equipment program, HVAC continues plumbing demos, and Environmental Conservation students will show rope-climbing techniques and share CDL training opportunities.

The booth is open on Saturday and Sunday too. On Saturday, Culinary students will prepare grilled sourdough melts with house-made chips. Graphic Design will offer a T-shirt activity and program overview. The Early College Career Academy will explain how high school students can earn college credit at no cost. On Sunday, Culinary students will teach children to make crepes. Criminal Justice students will demonstrate fingerprint lifting. Auto Body students return with another repair session, and Horticulture students will guide boutonniere-making.

"We are all about building and developing youth into active and contributing members of their communities," said Cathy Sweet, the 4-H Positive Youth **Development Educator for Cornell Cooperative**

Extension. "The Washington County Fair is a great platform for them to experience many of these opportunities."

4-H offers many activities through four pillars -Science, Technology, Engineering, Math; Healthy Living; Citizenship, Leadership; and Animal Science. Young people spend a great deal of time preparing for the fair each year. "While not all project work can be

entered in the fair, youth can be very creative in exhibiting the new skills and knowledge they've gained throughout the

year," Sweet said. The range of youth participation is extensive. Some members raise and show animals such as dairy and beef

All submissions are judged using the Danish System. "They work hard and gain valuable hands on food prep and customer service skills along with team work experience that can help them later when applying for jobs," said Sweet.




The Big Push Birthing Center is staffed by volunteers experienced with caring for dairy cows. They will answer questions from visitors and will keep the animals comfortable and safe.
